### Louisville Glassworks

Explore the [Louisville Glassworks](#) building, where you will find two glass studios and two galleries featuring spectacular glass art! Tours are offered daily for the glassblowing and flameworking studios, so you can see the artists at work. There even is a walk-in glass workshop class to create your own masterpiece.

### Kentucky Museum of Art & Craft

Established in 1981, the [Kentucky Museum of Art & Craft](#) in Louisville was formed to support the artistic history of the state. Many exhibits at the museum educate visitors on the various art forms and showcase unique art pieces.

### Nulu

Coined Nulu, the “New Louisville,” [East Market District](#) is known for its art galleries, specialty stores, antique shops and restaurants. With plenty to do, this trendy and growing area is a great way to spend a few hours while visiting downtown Louisville.

### Louisville River Walk

The [Louisville River Walk](#) is a scenic trail that travels through downtown Louisville along the river. The trail is over 20 miles long, depending on where you start, and is paved most of the way for easy walking and bike riding.

### Derby Dinner Playhouse
