Louisville Slugger Museum

One of the city's most popular attractions, the [Louisville Slugger Museum's](#) location is must-see spot in Louisville. You will easily find this building, marked by the World's Biggest Baseball Bat that leans against the side of the building. Over 3 million people have come to visit the museum to learn about the history of the official bat of Major League Baseball. Allow at least 2 hours to tour the museum!

- **Hours:** (Jan. 1st-June 30th, and Aug. 12th – Dec. 31st): Monday–Saturday 9a.m - 5p.m. and Sunday 11a.m. - 5p.m., (July 1st-Aug. 11th): Monday–Thursday 9a.m. - 6p.m., Friday–Saturday 9a.m. – 8p.m. and Sunday 11a.m. – 6p.m.
- **Cost:** Adults (\$11), Seniors (\$10), Kids (\$6), Children 5 & under (free)

Muhammad Ali Center

A tribute to the great [Muhammad Ali](#), this attraction features media presentations and interactive exhibits that follow the life and mission of Ali. Focusing on Ali's core values of respect, confidence, conviction, dedication, giving and spirituality, the Center is an educational experience for children and adults alike.

- **Hours:** Sunday 12p.m. – 5p.m., Tuesday – Saturday 9:30a.m. – 5 p.m., Closed on Mondays
- **Cost:** Adults (\$9), Seniors (\$8), Military and Students (\$5), Children ages 6-12 (\$4)

Louisville Zoo

Opened in 1960, our [Louisville Zoo](#) today features more than 1,300 animals. With animals as varied as tigers to albino alligators to gorillas to kangaroos, the six geographic settings offer experiences from around the globe. Visitors can also enjoy free admission to the Calistoga Splash Park to cool off in the hot summer sun.

- **Hours:** March 16th- Labor Day 10a.m. – 5 p.m., September to mid-March: 10a.m. to 4p.m.
- **Cost:** Adults (\$18.95), Children & Seniors (\$14.95)

Louisville Mega Cavern

The man-made [Louisville Mega Cavern](#) is 17 miles of corridors located just beneath the city. Visitors will hop on a SUV-pulled tram for an exciting adventure touring the underground for about 60-70 minutes.

- **Hours:** (January 16th-March 31st): 9a.m. – 3:30p.m., (April 1st-October 26th): 9a.m. – 5p.m., (November 15th-January 1st): 6p.m.-10p.m. for the [Underground Holiday Lights Show](#)
- **Costs:** Adults (\$13.50), Children (\$8), Seniors and Military (\$12)

Kentucky Science Center

Great for any age, the [Kentucky Science Center](#) offers exciting interactive exhibits to engage your mind! There's also an IMAX theater that shows films about the natural and earth sciences to life sciences and health.

- **Hours:** Sunday-Thursday 9:30a.m. - 5p.m., Friday-Saturday 9:30a.m. – 9p.m.
- **Cost:** \$5 for everyone after 5p.m. on Friday and Saturday, Adult (\$13), Children (\$11) – This does not include additional exhibit fees or IMAX ticket

Kentucky Derby Museum at Louisville Churchill Downs

The [Kentucky Derby Museum](#), which sits on the front steps of Churchill Downs, is one of the premiere attractions in Louisville. Welcoming more than 210,000 guests each year, the museum provides a first-hand look at the event for which the Derby City is known worldwide. The Museum also aims to provide a lasting impression of tradition, hospitality and pride to our many visitors.

- **Hours:** (March 15th-November 30th): Monday –Saturday 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Sunday 11a.m. – 5p.m.
(December 1st-March 14th): Monday –Saturday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., Sunday 11a.m. – 5p.m.
- **Cost:** Adults (\$14), Seniors (\$13), Young Adults (\$11), Children (\$6)
