### Bourbon Distilleries

### Louisville Slugger Museum/Walk of Fame

Over 3 million people have come to visit the museum to learn about the history of the official bat of Major League Baseball. Allow at least 2 hours to tour the museum!

### Muhammad Ali Center

A tribute to the great [Muhammad Ali](#), this attraction features media presentations and interactive exhibits that follow the life and mission of Ali. Focusing on Ali’s core values of respect, confidence, conviction, dedication, giving and spirituality, the Center is an educational experience for children and adults alike.
