Belle of Louisville

Nearly 100 years old, the [Belle of Louisville](#) is a historic steamboat that cruises down the Ohio River. As the last true Mississippi river steamboat in operation, the boat has taken nearly 7 million people for a ride and continues to offer cruises to the public with lunch and dinner buffet dining options. Huber's Orchard & Winery

The [Huber's Orchard & Winery](#) has been a family owned business since 1843. With over 600 acres of fruit and grapes grown on the estate, everything from the vine to bottling is done on the property. Come take a tour of the wine operations and taste some of the spectacular wines made at the venue. The winery is about a half hour away from downtown Louisville. Waterfront Park

This 84-acre [Waterfront Park](#) abutting the Ohio River features walking paths, open lawn area, fountains, a playground and more. The park is one of the top year-round attractions in Louisville, hosting a variety of special events and festivals.

Derby Dinner Playhouse

The [Louisville River Walk](#) is a scenic trail that travels through downtown Louisville along the river. The trail is over 20 miles long, depending on where you start, and is paved most of the way for easy walking and bike riding.
