Kentucky Derby Museum at Louisville Churchill Downs

The [Kentucky Derby Museum](#), which sits on the front steps of Churchill Downs, is one of the premiere attractions in Louisville. Welcoming more than 210,000 guests each year, the museum provides a first-hand look at the event for which the Derby City is known worldwide. The Museum also aims to provide a lasting impression of tradition, hospitality and pride to our many visitors.

Frazier International History Museum

Located in the West Main District of downtown Louisville, the [Frazier International History Museum](#) showcases Royal Armories artifacts. Among the many exhibits, the museum also has a movie theater and daily live performances of historical interpretations.
